ABOUT THE VIDEOS

These videos are a tool for engaging youth (approx 12-18 years old), in discussion around what it means to be a rebel. Too often the word 'rebel' or 'rebellion' is used to describe poor choices that we make. These choices are often the result of our deep desire for freedom, love, connection... However, we often end up just doing what the other 'rebels' are doing, not discovering our true self and merely 'fitting in'.

These 5 videos are meant to help youth critically engage with 'youth culture', break down how we think about rebellion and build capacity to actively engage in lives of love. These videos build on each other to a climax challenge of treating all people with dignity, respect and love.

A MESSAGE FROM KEN

I have been working with youth since shortly after my own teen years. The choices I made during my own teen years led me to ask the question, "Why?" Why did I do the things I did? Make the choices I made? (particularly the harmful ones). I came to realize that all of my 'rebellion' wasn't really 'rebellion' at all... As I started interacting with and speaking with groups of youth, I was so inspired by the rebellious spirit of youth and the opportunity it presents for young people to change everything!

15 years after starting my first job with youth in a group home for teenaged boys, I am now close to completing my Master of Social Work degree. I am indebted to the many youth and colleagues who have taught me so much along the way. The True Rebel Challenge is not just my challenge to others because of all I've learned, it is a daily challenge to myself as I still try to figure out, everyday, how to love people really, really well.
